Saint John's Bible Print Exhibit
at the Scott County Historical Society
April 20 – March 22, 2010

(SHAKOPEE, MN 3/01/2010) —Between April 20 and May 22, 2010, the Scott County Historical Society will host a twenty-five print exhibition of *The Saint John's Bible* at the Stans Museum in Shakopee. As the first handwritten, illuminated Bible to be commissioned in over 500 years, this exhibit offers a stunning presentation of art and history. A team of artists coordinated by Donald Jackson in Wales and a team of scholars in Central Minnesota have brought together the ancient techniques of calligraphy and illumination with an ecumenical Christian approach to the Bible. The result is a living document and a monumental achievement.

The exhibit includes hands-on activities for children and adults to gain a deeper understanding of the artistic process. The Society is currently accepting reservations for guided tours.
